JOINT RESOLUTION

To solidify a partnership between the Texas Military Preparedness Commission and the Southwest Defense Alliance of working together to preserve and promote military missions, assets, infrastructures and the defense industrial base in Texas and the Southwest United States.

WHEREAS, the Texas Military Preparedness is composed of 13 members appointed by the Governor of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Defense Alliance is composed of representatives from the state of Arizona, California, Nevada, New Mexico, Texas, and Utah; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Military Preparedness Commission is statutorily charged to advise the legislature and governor on defense and military issues; and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Defense Alliance is a nonprofit, nonpartisan, community based organization dedicated to supporting defense, energy and industry for National Security and America's Warfighter; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to have a strong economy and industrial base for a strong defense; and

WHEREAS, regional alliances working towards a common goal supplement and enhance the individual strength of advocate organizations; and

THEREFORE, be it affirmed, the partnership between the Texas Military Preparedness Commission and the Southwest Defense Alliance of working together to preserve and promote military missions, assets, infrastructures and the defense industrial base in Texas and the Southwest United States is necessary for regional security and longevity.
