

TEXAS' PORTS OF ENTRY

Texas has 32 official ports of entry that serve as critical gateways to global trade. Each port, whether an airport, land port or seaport, serves many domestic and international economic activities across multiple industries. The Lone Star State is home to the #1 port in the U.S. for waterborne foreign trade—the Port of Houston—and the #1 international trade port in the U.S.—Port Laredo. Each Texas ports of entry play a distinctive role in the state's robust transportation network and contribute to the state and local economies.
