

MEDIA PRODUCTION DEVELOPMENT ZONE PROGRAM

The Media Production Development Zone Program (MPDZ) is designed to encourage the further development of permanent production facilities and to help strengthen the Texas economy.

MPDZ allows for a sales and use tax exemption for the construction, maintenance, expansion, improvement, or renovation of a media production facility at a qualified media production location in Texas over a two-year period.

Media production facilities include but are not limited to:


- animation studios
- CGI studios
- post production facilities
- sound stages
- video game development studios
- production office space

The review process evaluates a variety of factors associated with each project including, but not limited to:

- job creation and wages
- capital investment
- return on state investment
- financial strength of the applicant
- the applicant's business history
- analysis of the relevant business sector
- public and private sector financial support
