CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS OVERVIEW

WHY CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS?

- To improve the campus community
- To provide alternative means to solve and reduce crime
- To create a formal method for students to report crime to school administration
- To help reduce youth violence
- To promote safety in Texas Schools
- To comply with S.B. 179 "David's Law"

CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS OVERVIEW



Types of Campus Crime Stoppers Organizations

Independently Certified

An independent 501 (c)(3) nonprofit corporation consistent with Texas Law, Chapter 414, Texas Government Code and certified by Texas Crime Stoppers Council.

UMBRELLA

(Student Board)

An umbrella program of an existing community Crime Stoppers program, comprised of and operated by a student board, defined as a campus Crime Stoppers program.

SCHOOL SAFETY

(No Student Boar

An umbrella program of an existing community Crime Stoppers program, operated by community program's board of directors.

CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS OVERVIEW



INDEPENDENTLY CERTIFIED CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS

FORMATION:

- Procedures are the same as starting a certified community Crime Stoppers organization (Texas Secretary of State, IRS, Texas Comptroller, etc.)
- Organization is a separate entity operating independent of a local community Crime Stoppers organization.
- All bank accounts and Crime Stoppers records are maintained separately from the school district.
- Enter into an agreement with the school administration, describing roles and responsibilities of involved parties

INDEPENDENTLY CERTIFIED CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS

CRIME STOPPERS AGREES TO...

- Establish a school chapter and pay cash rewards to students and others who report crimes
- Offer a coordinated plan
- \bullet Fund the campus Crime Stoppers program
- Provide use of its system to receive calls, web tips, or text messages, and a website
- Forward information received to designated school personnel

CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS OVERVIEW



INDEPENDENTLY CERTIFIED CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS

SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION AGREES TO...

- The operation is sole responsibility of the campus board of directors, with assistance of the local community CS organization
- · Appoint a "sponsor/coordinator"
- Provide appropriate time and facilities for students, school personnel, and school resource officer(s) to attend orientation and training
- Promote the campus Crime Stoppers program

UMBRELLA CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS

FORMATION:

- Consult your organization's bylaws
- Enter into an agreement with the school administration, describing roles and responsibilities of involved parties

CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS OVERVIEW



UMBRELLA CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS

BOARD

• Organized group of student volunteers representing a cross-section of the campus

BOARD FUNCTIONS:

- Review crimes
- Offer cash rewards
- All Crime Stoppers records are maintained separate from school records

COORDINATOR:

- May be a representative of law enforcement
- Coordinator and sponsor may be the same
- Generally appointed by school administration or a law enforcement agency
