STUDENTS ASK!

“HOW CAN I SUBMIT A TIP?”

SMHS STUDENTS QUESTION HOW THEY CAN SUBMIT TIPS AND HOW THEY ARE HANDLED BY CAMPUS CRIME STOPPERS.

San Marcos High School Students and staff can submit tips by using the P3 Tips app, going to the Hays County Crime Stoppers website on their phone or computer or by calling 1-800-324-TIPS (8477). Tips could include information about, bullying, drug and alcohol use on campus, weapons, self harm, etc.

When submitting a tip, students give descriptions of what the crime is, who the suspect is, where it happened, and any other important information.

When a tip is submitted to Crime Stoppers, it is then forwarded to campus officials or law enforcement for a follow-up. Not every tip gets acted on immediately, but every tip is important and taken seriously.

If a student's tip leads to an arrest, disciplinary action, or helps stop a crime on campus, the tipster could be eligible to get a cash reward. Reporting to Campus Crime Stoppers is a great way of keeping our schools safe and to help build a stronger connection between the students, staff, and SRO's.
