







Q9 Do you know the penalty or fine for misuse of an accessible parking space?





Q11 Do you monitor the use of accessible parking spaces at your business?













Q17 If you hear concerns or complaints from customers about accessible parking, please indicate how often you hear these concerns.







Q22 Do you agree with the following statement? "Businesses should add more accessible parking for customers with disabilities."



Q23 Do you agree with the following statement? "Accessible parking fraud and abuse is widespread in the business community."





Q25 Do you agree with the following statement? "A combination of fines and education is the best way to reduce accessible parking fraud and abuse."






