







Total Enrollment Counts in Student Program and Special Populations Reports



# 86th Texas Legislative Session Highlight




# **SB 1557- (TEC § 33.909, § 25.006)** Purple Star Campus Designation

- Two new PEIMS indicator codes allowing districts to identify:
  - Students with a parent or guardian who are veterans
  - Students dependents of a member in the military or reserve force who have fallen in the line of duty
- TEA's rulemaking process
- Texas Register public comment period: January 10<sup>th</sup>





# 86th Texas Legislative Session Highlight



- Applies to active duty military, guard/reserve members who receive military orders assigning them to a military installation in Texas.
- Service members may elect to enroll their students in any district that is adjacent to the installation.
- Proof of physical residency in the district must be provided to the district no later than 10 days
  after the arrival date specified in the military orders.
- Continuing enrollment is contingent on the service members residing in the district.





#### **Priorities and Goals**

#### **Priority Project 1:**

Increase the number of military-connected students being identified by school districts and open-enrollment charter schools by *3%*.



#### **Priority Project 2:**

Create a suite of resources for ESCs, LEAs and stakeholders to increase awareness and mitigate transitional barriers.


#### **Solutions**


- Development of tool-kit with information specific to the military student identifier.
- Foster collaborations and partnerships.










