Dear Ms. Garfield:

As a result of severe storms and tornadoes that occurred in Polk County on April 22, 2020, many homes and businesses were affected in the area, creating an economic emergency for the residents of the county.

Pursuant to the provisions of 15 U.S.C. § 636(b)(2) and 13 C.F.R. § 123.3(a), I request that the Small Business Administration declare Polk County a disaster area for the purpose of making long-term, low-interest rate physical disaster home and business loans and economic injury disaster loans available to citizens and businesses affected by the disaster. A preliminary survey indicates that there are more than 64 homes and/or businesses in Polk County that suffered an uninsured loss of more than 40 percent.
