
SBA Still Accepting Late Applications for Hurricane Harvey in Texas

Can I still apply for an SBA disaster loan?

Yes. The application filing deadline for physical damage closed on November 30, 2017; however, SBA is still accepting late applications from disaster survivors if there were substantial causes beyond the applicant's control that prevented them from being able to submit an application within the filing deadline. Disaster survivors who have not yet applied for SBA disaster loan assistance to help with physical losses should act quickly. SBA provides loans to homeowners, renters, business of all sizes, and nonprofit organizations to help repair or replace physical losses not covered by insurance or other sources of recoveries.

SBA also provides working capital loans, called Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDLs), to help small business, small agricultural cooperatives, small businesses engaged in aquaculture, and most private, nonprofit organizations of all sizes meet their ordinary and necessary financial obligations that cannot be met as a direct result of the disaster. The filing deadline to apply for economic injury is open until May 25, 2018.

How can I apply for an SBA disaster loan?

Disaster survivors can apply 1) online; 2) in-person at a Disaster Recovery Center; or 3) by mail.
