A RIDER IN THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 89TH LEGISLATURE REGULAR SESSION, SENATE BILL 1

Sec. 17.19. Department of Transportation: Direction for Aviation Services Funded in House Bill 500.

Contingent upon the enactment of House Bill 500 or similar legislation relating to making supplemental appropriations and reductions in appropriations and giving direction and adjustment authority regarding appropriations by the Eighty-ninth Legislature, Regular Session, the Department of Transportation shall use \$106,800,000 from the General Revenue Fund appropriated in HB 500, Section 7.03, to provide funding for the following projects in the following amounts:

- (1) \$10,000,000 for South Texas International Airport;
- (2) \$14,800,000 for McKinney National Airport;
- (3) \$8,000,000 for Emergency and First Responder Airport Facilities;
- (4) \$14,000,000 for Athens Municipal Airport;
- (5) \$10,000,000 for Weslaco Mid-Valley Airport Runway Expansion.
- (6) Unexpended balance authority remaining from appropriations made in the General Appropriations Act, 88th Legislature, Article IX, Sec. 17.40, Emergency and First Responder Airport Facilities, (estimated to be \$0), is appropriated for the same purpose;
- (7) \$40,000,000 for Reese Airport Upgrades; and
- (8) \$10,000,000 for East Texas Regional Airport Upgrades.
