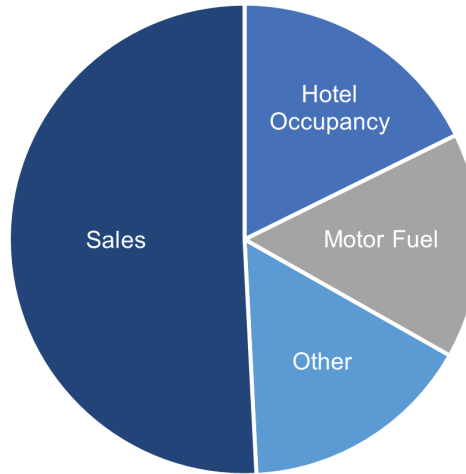


STATE AND LOCAL TAXES

Traveler spending contributes significant tax revenue to both state and local governments. Taxes generated by travel support public sector jobs like fire fighters, police officers

Travel-Generated State Tax Revenue



★ IMPACT ★

\$5.5 billion in state taxes and an additional \$3.7 billion in local taxes is the equivalent of \$822 saved per Texas household in 2025.

★ **\$9.2 Billion** State and local taxes generated by travel

★ **5.9%** Share of state revenue

★ **4.0%** Share of local revenue

What tax revenues are generated by travel?

State taxes directly generated by travel include sales, hotel occupancy, motor fuel, and other taxes. Local taxes primarily include lodging taxes imposed by cities, counties, and other tax jurisdictions in Texas. Both state and local tax estimates also include additional tax revenues attributable to travel industry businesses and employees.
